July 24 starts the Mike Bos Chassis Craft Jr. Dragster Nationals held in Bristol Tennessee. Positioned one weekend before final eliminations in the Eastern Conference Finals, the Mike Bos Chassis Craft Junior Dragster Nationals is becoming one of the greatest junior dragster events in the Southeast.

The Mike Bos Jr. Dragster Nationals take place July 24-25 and provide a convenient option for racers hoping to tune their cars to compete at Bristol Dragway. The event kicks off a full eight days of junior dragster action.

Drivers will race in one of four age groups, 8-9, 10-12, 13-14 and 15-17, and compete for U.S. Savings Bonds that will be awarded to the top finishers.

Each season, racers from throughout the eastern United States and Canada take their shot at Wally's and a share of close to \$100,000 in savings bonds during the NHRA Jr. Drag Racing League Eastern Conference Finals. The event is open to racers in Divisions 1, 2, and 3, and select tracks in Division 4, and each NHRA member track may send up to three teams of 10 racers to the event. The 2010 Eastern Conference Finals will take place July 29-31 at Bristol Dragway in Bristol, Tenn.
